"Told You So"

We've all experienced those moments when we automatically think, "told you so," but in kindness/wisdom (hopefully) avoid actually saying it. This past week a visitor to the cemetery who has family buried in our cemetery from years ago, called to complain about the conditions of certain graves that have cement/gravel and that have caved in. Apart from the lecture at their astonishment, it serves as a good reminder of a couple of things: first, why it was necessary to cease allowing curbing and concrete/gravel additions to continue...as future generations (like those of today in some cases) do not visit or care for the graves of their loved ones due to changing times and in many cases, no family living here any longer; secondly, a reminder that grave decor is the family's responsibility (done according to our posted rules and regulations). The cemetery simply cannot "financially" fix leaning/falling gravestones or broken/crumbling grave coverage. When "settling" occurs we do add soil--but any sort of maintenance that goes beyond spraying and mowing is not part of the cemetery responsibility. This is not to be cold or cruel about sensitive concerns, but a statement of reality and responsibility.

Not a Registered Parishioner?

If you have not taken the time to register as a parishioner, please take a moment and stop by the Pastoral Center to pick up a Census form or call and one will be mailed to you. Why is it important to register? As a registered parishioner you are afforded the opportunity to buy cemetery lots at the parishioner rate as opposed to a non-parishioner rate. Registered parishioners are also provided a funeral luncheon, provided by the parish, and the use of the Family Center. Registered parishioners also receive the Catholic Lighthouse at no cost. If sending a child/children to St. Joseph School the tuition rate is lower than the non-parishioner tuition rate. As a registered parishioner you become an official member of the parish family. There are no strings attached. Simply fill out the form and return to the parish office.

Rita of Cascia devoted her life to the care of plague victims, without ever becoming infected with the disease.
