## "Goings On" Update

--St. Ann Driveway is nearing completion and is looking great. As mentioned previously, there will be a few adjustments with the addition of the pavement. One is the plan to cease using the little "drive-thru" section of the cemetery—opening up more burial space possibilities in light of the lost ones when the sewer system for the Pavilion was installed.

--St. Joseph Cemetery Pavilion is still coming along. Framing and construction of the wall and pillars is underway. The next step then is the addition of the window and columbaria and then we will be able to speak about a finish date.

--Parking Lot addition plans are in process as we must go through the proper municipal channels to gain the necessary permissions to move ahead. Bids have been collected—and although a little more than expected (perhaps due to the addition of the lot next to the old pre-k), we are still hoping to move ahead when possible. In the next weeks we will have the simple metal storage building added at the rear of this section.

## A "Ruined" Photo Op

In the last few months there have been a few requests to have access to the old ruins of St. Joseph Church (ruins below the cemetery). Unfortunately—due to liability and safety reasons—it is not possible to go inside the area around the ruins for a photo shoot. As picturesque as it might seem—consider the other side of the interpretation of such photos—glimpses of hope and excitement—using a background of burnt, decaying, crumbling religious ruins...not the best match-up of ideals/symbols.
