Cemetery Pavilion Update

As you may have seen the Pavilion Project is getting much closer to completion. The statue of St. Joseph that was put in place is actually from a convent in Connecticut where the good sisters were downsizing and had moved into a smaller, newer convent. It is a 1920's hand carved statue of St. Joseph with the child Jesus who is holding a small cross. The phrase on the front in Latin states, "Custos Iesu, Custos Noster," meaning Guardian of Jesus, Our Guardian. This antique is a beautiful work of art depicting our patron--and the patron of a happy death--that sits atop a pedestal listing donors and memorials who assisted in making this project a success.
