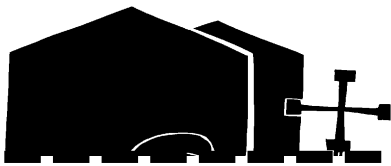

The Emmaus Center:

Counseling in the Catholic Tradition

The Diocese of Victoria--as a way of better engaging the Jubilee Year of Mercy our Holy Father has called--has established a new Catholic Counseling Center, called, The Emmaus Center. It will begin accepting clients on Monday, November 9. Initially, the staff will be part-time, and the hours limited, but the hope is to be full time, as soon as possible. The Center is located in Laurent Towers

at 1908 N. Laurent Street, Suite 140, in Victoria. Since there is no receptionist at this time, all appointments are made via the counseling center website. The website has already been posted to the websites of the Diocese of Victoria and St. Joseph Parish. As soon as time allows, brochures will be available for display in all of our parishes and schools. We hope the Center will grow over the next several months and the intention is to begin providing spiritual direction and bilingual counseling, as soon as trained professionals are found to fill these positions.
