### **St. Joseph School Sets Registration March 21<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>**

St. Joseph School will begin registration for the Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 programs and new students K-8 for the 2016-2017 school year beginning March 21<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>. Parents may register in the school office from 9:00-11:00 A.M. and 1:00-3:00 P.M. Parents are required at the time of registration to present the students baptismal and/or official birth certificates and a complete immunization record. No child will be completely registered unless all of these documents are provided. A registration fee of \$200 per student is required. After the deadline of March 31<sup>st</sup> the registration fee will be \$225. Parents are encouraged to register students before April 1<sup>st</sup>.
