### Chrim Mass

All are invited to the annual Chrim Mass at Our Lady of Victory Cathedral in Victoria on (this) Tuesday of Holy Week at 10:00 A.M. This Mass is celebrated by the Bishop with all the priests of the diocese during which the three Holy Oils are blessed and consecrated, and distributed to each of the priests for use in this upcoming year. It is a special moment in the life of the local Church and is a unique and beautiful experience.

### Sacred Triduum

We are at the most sacred time of year as we will enter into the high holy days recalling and celebrating our salvation through the Paschal Mystery. All parishioners--especially families together--are encouraged to set time aside from their schedules and fully participate in these special liturgies. The rituals and symbols involved are a true feast for the senses--bring your Lent to its culmination and enter into the mystery and renew your faith and devotion.

### “Could you not stay awake with me for an hour?”

This Thursday following the Mass of the Lord's Supper the Church will remain open until midnight for the prayerful nightwatch. It is a silent and truly spiritual time during which all are invited to come and spend time with our Lord recalling the saving events we are commemorating during the Sacred Triduum. Families are especially encouraged to bring their children for a least a few moments to pray and be with the Lord. There are so many graces available during these intensely spiritual days.

### Reminder

Holy Communion may not be brought to the hospital, nursing home or homebound on Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Holy Saturday due to the Sacred Triduum and the Church's liturgical law. The practice of bringing Holy Communion resumes with Easter Sunday.

## **St. Joseph School Sets Registration March 21<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>**

St. Joseph School will begin registration for the Pre-K 3 and Pre-K 4 programs and new students K-8 for the 2016-2017 school year beginning March 21<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>. Parents may register in the school office from 9:00-11:00 A.M. and 1:00-3:00 P.M. Parents are required at the time of registration to present the students baptismal and/or official birth certificates and a complete immunization record. No child will be completely registered unless all of these documents are provided. A registration fee of \$200 per student is required. After the deadline of March 31<sup>st</sup> the registration fee will be \$225. Parents are encouraged to register students before April 1<sup>st</sup>. St. Joseph School admits students of any religion, race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

## **Join Me in the Pledge to Stop Christian Genocide**

*A Statement from Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of  
Louisville, President of the United States Conference  
of Catholic Bishops.*

Today, the people of God must speak up for our brothers and sisters facing genocide in the Middle East. I urge every Catholic to sign the petition at [www.stopthechristiengenocide.org](http://www.stopthechristiengenocide.org). As a people of faith, we must convince the United States Department of State to include Christians in any formal declaration of genocide. For months, the Catholic Church has been a voice for Christians and other religious minorities facing the evil of deadly persecution. Now, the State Department is expected to make a decision within days. A resolution, H. Con. Res. 75, is also gaining bipartisan support in Congress. Please, make sure your name is added to the witness. The very future of the ancient Christian presence in the Middle East is at stake. I am grateful to my brother bishops, the Knights of Columbus and all the faithful who have struggled to keep a focus on suffering Christians in the national debate. Rest assured of my continued prayers and support. With each passing day, the roll of modern martyrs grows. While we rejoice in their ultimate victory over death through the power of Jesus' love, we must also help our fellow Christians carry the Cross of persecution and, as much as possible, help relieve their suffering. By doing so, the Middle East and the world will be made safer for people of every faith to live in peace.
