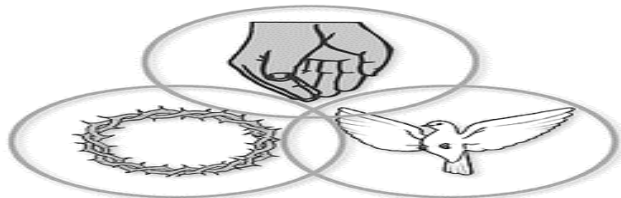
## Vacation Bible School

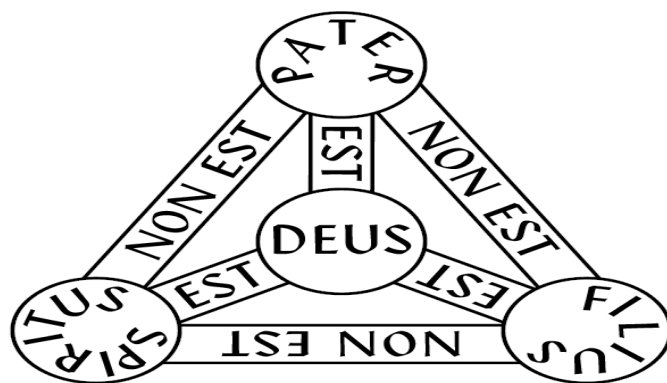


