Most will remember the "old days" when an adult who wanted to be baptized or received into the Church would undergo several meetings with Father then "become" Catholic. The best way to get a good and broad overview of the Church and its teachings is the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.). It begins on September 11th, meets weekly (except holidays) and concludes at Easter when the candidates receive all of their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation). Khrist Ford is a Board Certified and Licensed Professional Counselor and Supervisor in the State of Texas, and Founder and former Executive Director of My Healing Place, Austin's Center for Grief, Loss, and Trauma. Khrist has spent the past 25 years working with children and adults who have experienced a significant or traumatic loss. Ms. Ford holds a Master's degree in Counselor Education, is a Certified Grief and Trauma Specialist and School Consultant, and a trained spiritual director. Ms. Ford's training and life experience as a bereaved parent and spouse fuel her passion for the transformative work of grief in the lives of children, adolescents and adults. Prior to the founding of My Healing Place in Austin, TX., Khrist served as the Director of Program Development and Training for Bo's Place, Houston's center for grieving children and their families. Khrist has offered grief retreats and workshops for grieving adults and parents throughout Texas. Khrist was also an adjunct instructor for the School of Social Work at the University of Texas in Austin, teaching the "Grief Counseling and Therapy" course for graduate students.

Janie Cook M Ed, MA in Theology, lives in Austin with her husband, Gareth. Janie is a retired teacher, both in special education and religious studies, has served on the educational ministries staff in the Methodist Church and been a volunteer pastoral care assistant in St. Luke's Hospital and Methodist Hospital in Houston. She and Gareth are the grateful parents of two - a daughter, Laurie, who is married with two children and a son, Matt, who died in April, 2007. Since the summer of 2008, Janie has been a participant in the bereavement ministry of her church, past Board member and chair for the Board of Directors of My Healing Place where she currently facilitates two bereaved parents support groups.

This ecumenical retreat is open to bereaved parents - couples, single mothers and fathers. The retreat will begin on Friday evening, October 14th and conclude with lunch on Sunday, October 16th. **The cost for this retreat is \$250.00 per parent, which covers speaker fees, all meals and lodging for two nights.
