In an attempt to better address this we are looking at contracting for annual service on the drains/grease trap so this doesn't occur again. Sincerest apologies to those who were using

the facility during the weekend only to find that the restrooms, sinks, urinals, etc. could not be used. Hopefully those who endured this less-than-seasonal ambience all get moved to the top of Santa's "nice" list...no matter how "naughty" the festive hardship may have been.
