That Man Is You

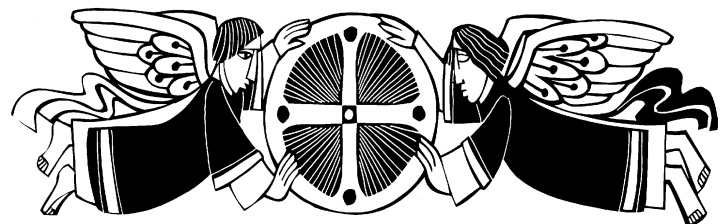

There are plenty of opportunities to avail oneself if one desires to. For more information or contacts for any of the above just all the parish office.

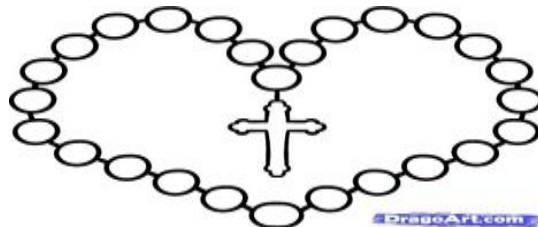
Annual Blessing of Animals
