So be aware that not all intentions can be scheduled for weekends--some must be for weekdays. Scheduling can be done at the St. Joseph Pastoral Center during office hours for Sweet Home, Koerth, Hochheim and Yoakum. One should not simply drop a note to the Pastoral Center and assume a particular date is open--important that you speak with the staff to guarantee dates are open before making an assumption.

Parish Blood Drive

Our parish is sponsoring a blood drive next Sunday, **October 15th** from 9:45 A.M. – 12:45 P.M. The South Texas Blood and Tissue Center mobile unit will be located on the Family Center parking lot.

Why Give Blood? There is no substitute for blood. It has to come from one person in order to give to another. In order to meet hospital demands the South Texas Blood and Tissue Center must collect sufficient units of blood to service 67 hospitals in 43 South Texas counties. The need for blood is constant, donors are needed every day. With the holiday season rapidly approaching it is crucial to collect as many units as possible.

Requirements: Anyone who is 16 years old and weighs at least 120 lbs. (with a parental consent form), or at least 17 years old and weighs at least 110 lbs., and in good general health can donate blood. Donor must present photo ID, last four digits of their Social Security number and their date of birth.

Scheduling an Appointment: Go to the South Texas Blood & Tissue Center (STBTC) at: www.donatingforlife.org. If this is the first time to donate to the STBTC, please look for the link that says, “I have never donated with STBTC. Make an appointment now.” If you have donated, click on Locate a Blood Drive, click on the date, click the time that is most convenient and then click on “Schedule”. If you have problems scheduling online then call the STBTC at 210-731-5555.

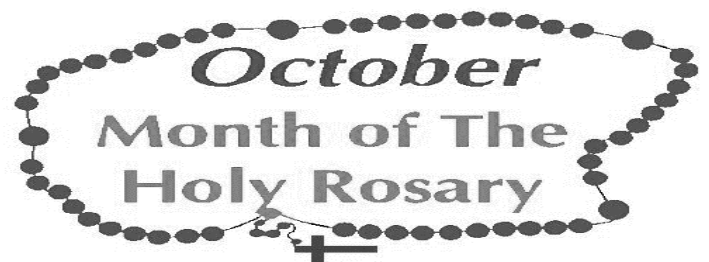
