Scheduling Mass Intentions

Beginning November 1st the 2018 calendar year for Masses is open for scheduling. **Each family may schedule one weekend Mass and up to three weekday Masses.** Remember, everyone wants to schedule weekend Masses and with the number of parishioners, it is virtually impossible that everyone can get the exact weekend. If you have more than four intentions to schedule (one weekend + three weekday) you can leave these with the office and they will be scheduled when openings come up in the future. As an example: last year, before the end of 2016 almost every Mass for 2017 was booked--and the weekend Masses were full by the end of November. Do not simply place an envelope with dated desired without first verifying with the office the dates are open. One must speak with the staff to guarantee dates are actually available before making an assumption. The offering for all Masses remains the same: \$5.

For Your Information

In the coming weeks the doors of the church are going to be removed in phases to have the exteriors stripped, sealed and refinished. The front entryway doors in particular took a lot of wind and rain during the storm and the finish took a beating. The side ramp entrance near the priest sacristy will remain useable, but there may be one weekend when the double front doors will be removed--the two single entry doors will remain. Basically it'll be a slight inconvenience that will allow the doors to be protected and returned for years of service ahead.
