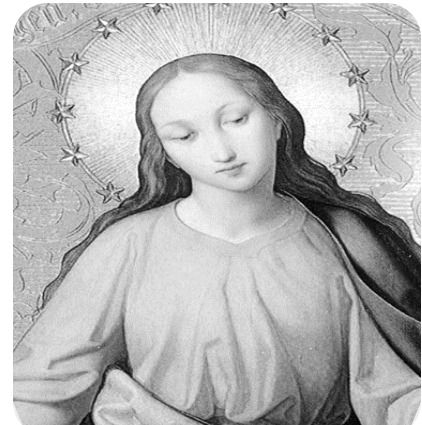
Want to Grow in Holiness, But Too Busy?
