School Windows Update

The workers have really been accomplishing a lot in a shorter amount of time than what was originally foreseen. It is quite possible that by the end of this coming week 99% of the work will be complete on the actual window installation. There are still a couple of minor issues that will have to await Spring Break when the power can be turned off in order to attend to certain panels that conduit passes through. This will also be the time in which the new electrical panel will be installed and the doors will be upgraded with the necessary hardware/panic bars--as well as the installation of the new security doors on the second floor barring anyone from entering the classroom area without being given access. Window treatments (vertical blinds) are on order and should start appearing in place in the next month or so. The "in between" phase (until spring break) will see some of the rooms get the needed attention regarding rot and water damage on the 3rd floor.
