**Orth & Victoria Streets Parking Lot:** We are awaiting the rest of the bids on the parking lot addition for the corner of Orth and Victoria streets. A metal storage building will be added at the rear of this area on land that was acquired some 7-8 years ago for this purpose. The storage building will be simple and allow us to centrally store all of the items (parish and school) we have scattered all over our property--from the gym to the Family Center to the garage to the garage apartment to the Pre-K upstairs. One central location with easy access--work should commence before the holidays...hopefully.
