## St. Joseph Cemetery Pavilion

Work has progressed some on the pavilion. It is still going to be some time before all is finished. In the next couple of weeks some trees will be placed around it to “dress” it up as well as more of the ongoing stucco work prep and finishing. As we are entering the cooler parts of the year and it is difficult to set a date for a dedication and then arrive at the date to find it too cold...the formal dedication will be on hold for a while until all is in place.

## St. Ann Driveway

It is looking as if our driveway project is being wrapped up. It looks great and should give us many, many years of service. As mentioned previously, the cemetery “drive-thru” is officially closed. To avoid a massive pileup at 6:55 A.M. on Sundays, and the ensuing issue of someone not being able to get to his parking place in time to vest...please utilize the basic rule of thumb that if heading around the Church proceed to the right side (cemetery side) and allow traffic to move that direction. The central entrance is wide enough to accommodate two vehicles passing each other in different directions—but—the path around the church is safest when only one vehicle is going and in the same direction. In coming weeks a few extras will be in place (dedicated handicap parking areas, etc.). And with this new “autobahn” at St. Ann’s, (it is definitely an einbahnstrasse around the Kirche) drive slowly...and even though it would be easy/fun to see how your car maneuvers on a smooth track at high speeds—as your mother would say, just because you can, doesn’t mean you have to. Word is that the tickets for violations of these “laws” are really going to be high—and the issuing authority promises a severe sermon with each issuance!
