Final Phase of Cemetery Project

Now that the roads have been reworked and surfaced, the final phase of the cemetery project is getting closer to moving ahead. This final phase is the addition of the Pavilion at the "T" in the new section. The rationale behind its location is that as time goes on the expansion of new graves in this area will mean more long term use/service. It is envisioned as an open Pavilion on three sides with a rear wall. On the rear wall will be a decorative element as well as two sets of columbaria (niches for the placement of cremains) on each side of the central decoration.
