## Cemetery Rules

New signs have been posted at both (St. Joseph and St. Ann) Cemeteries. The main revision/change concerns plots that are used for more than a single interment, i.e., adding cremains or infant burials to an already used or purchased existing plot. The rationale is that in order to keep records and the database up-to-date, additional interments must be logged and there is a limit to additions.

## St. Ann Driveway

As has been previously stated, the next step is "in the works" for the driveway at St. Ann. Updated and firm bids are being sought so as to be able to go ahead. One issue that has been put forth and should be noted is that the "driveway project" includes the entrance and drive around the church--along with a path to the Pavilion. The little "extra driveway" through the "new" section of the cemetery will not be included. One reason for this is that it may be converted into actual cemetery plots. With the addition of the Pavilion a few years back and its necessary septic system (for the toilet), a lot of land was lost--that would have been cemetery plots--in the rear section of the property. With more burials in the future this would provide extra interments near the Church that many have asked for in the past when choosing a place.

As can be seen, we are running out of plots near the Church, meaning we will be closer to the "outhouse" section in decades to come. And as one might expect with common wisdom--very few will probably ask to be laid to their eternal rest in this area--no matter how green and verdant the pasture may be. Once a bid has been accepted and approved we will make a note in the bulletin and then hopefully see some "concrete" progress.
