This past weekend at the K.J.Z.T. convention in Austin a couple of things occurred that honor our parish and its roots as the origins of this organization. ## The "Form" of Marriage

Although there are many issues involved with "getting married," for Catholics there are certain issues that must be remembered. A Catholic is bound to follow the form of the Church when entering matrimony. Basically this entails that the couple undergo premarital preparation/instruction before actually marrying. This applies not only to the marriage of two Catholics, but also any marriage between a Catholic and a non-Catholic. Consequences of choosing to marry without submitting to the form of the Church entail not being able to receive the sacraments--Holy Communion, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick (unless in grave or serious danger obviously) as well as being unable to serve as Godparent/sponsor for Baptism and Confirmation. If you have any question regarding your own situation simply call and speak with Father.

## FYI: Low Gluten Hosts

The Benedictine Sisters of Clyde, Missouri are our providers of our Low Gluten hosts. Recently they changed the manner in which they made these special hosts. They still meet the canonical requirements and are the same in content. In the past they made each host individually. They now are using a special press that results in a similar appearance and taste as the "regular" gluten hosts. For those who need these hosts this is simply to let you know that the hosts are the same recipe as before but have a more uniform appearance and are not as thick. To protect against "mixing" them they still are kept apart from the others. If you require these "special hosts," just request them from the Communion minister.

## An "Informed" Decision

Most will remember the "old days" when an adult who wanted to be baptized or received into the Church would undergo several meetings with Father and then "become" Catholic. The Church wants those who consider joining it to be as informed as possible about what "they are getting themselves into." The best way to get a good and broad overview of the Church and its teachings is the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. It begins in September, meets weekly (except holidays) and concludes at Easter when the candidates receive all of their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation). If you have been thinking about joining the Church or know someone who has always said that they are eventually going to become a Catholic, now is the time to encourage them to take the next step.
