SJS Project Update

The third floor is looking great as the painting is coming along in a timely manner. New lights are ready to be added as well as ceiling fans to some of the "new-old" rooms. As mentioned previously, the old "chapel" will serve as a Memorial Room where a book with deceased alumni will be kept near the crucifix with a vigil light. It will be our 8th grade who assume responsibility for maintaining this prayerful remembrance of those who called St. Joseph School their home as well. The second floor AC/Heat is in the process of being installed and should be complete soon. And the first floor is getting setup to welcome our Pre-K. The exterior cleaning was done by some of our school dads and the repainting of the School exterior painted areas is underway.
